Library Cards

Library cards are available free of charge for anyone who meets one of the following qualifications:

- Resident of Robeson County
- Owner of property in Robeson County
- Student or teacher in a Robeson County school, college or university

Application must be made in person and proof of identity and current address are required.

Applications for children under 18 must have the signature of a parent or legal guardian.

You may register for a library card at any Robeson County Public Library location. Phone and online registration options are not available at this time.

Non-Residents

Library privileges are available to residents of surrounding counties (Scotland, Hoke, Cumberland, Bladen, Columbus, and Dillon).

Identification and Proof of Current Address

Proof of identity and current address can be met by the following:

| Identification | Address |
|-------------------------------|---|
| State issued ID | Post marked piece of mail with patron's name and current address |
| Military ID | Lease, deed, or utility agreement with patron's name and current address |
| School or work ID card | Voter or car registration or insurance card with name and current address |
| Passport | Checkbook with name and current address |
| Any other official picture ID | Pay stub with name and current address |

Account Renewal

Library cards expire every two years. Patrons will need to visit any location to update the information on their card. Identification and proof of current address will be required when updating library cards.

Replacing a Library Card

Replacement cards are available with a valid photo ID for \$1.00.
